Privacy Policy V2

1. The Policy

This privacy policy explains how we comply with GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), the DPA (Data Protection Act) [pre GDPR enforcement] and the PECR (Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations).

Personal data held on Club Members

The club holds personal data on members in order to operate as a bowls club. This data will be used for organising bowls matches, which may be friendly matches against other clubs, league matches, internal club competitions, county competitions and other events. The club also runs social events.

A list of members and their contract details will be made available to all members of the club to enable them to contact other members for the purposes of arranging matches, sharing transport and organising volunteers for rotas (e.g. catering and cleaning).

Results of matches may be reported on the club website and in the local newsletter and these may mention people by name. Personal information (i.e. name and contact phone number) is also passed to the RBCCA for the purposes of organising County Competitions.

2. The Club website

Use of Cookies

This website uses cookies to improve the users experience while visiting the website. As required by legislation, where applicable this website uses a cookie control system, allowing the user to give explicit permission or to deny the use of / saving of cookies on their computer / device.

What are Cookies
